

Leadership NPQs

For teachers looking to progress into senior leadership and beyond. The following NPQs build foundational knowledge to lead rapid improvement in a school, or lead on trust's key development priorities whilst all the time creating and embedding a culture that allows the school, staff and pupils to thrive.



NPQ in Executive Leadership (NPQEL)

Designed for school leaders who are, or are aspiring to be, an executive headteacher or a school trust CEO with responsibility for leading several schools.



NPQ in Headship (NPQH)

Aimed at senior school leaders who are, or are aspiring to be, a headteacher or head of school with responsibility for leading a school.



NPQ in Senior Leadership (NPQSL)

To develop skills and knowledge for school leaders who are, or are aspiring to be, a senior leader with cross-school responsibilities.



NPQ in Early Years Leadership (NPQEYL)

For leaders who are, or are working towards becoming managers of Private, Voluntary and Independent nurseries, heads of school-based or maintained nurseries, or childminders with leadership responsibilities.



NPQ Special Educational Needs Coordinator (NPQSENCO)

For school leaders or teachers who are interested in developing expertise in SEND or current SENCOs. This NPQ became mandatory for new SENCOs from September 2024.



Specialist NPQs

The following programmes are for those who have, or are aspiring to have, responsibilities for leading teaching in a subject or year, leading behaviour and/or supporting pupil wellbeing in their school, or leading the development of other teachers in their school.



NPQ in Leading Teaching (NPQLT)

This programme is for teachers who have, or are aspiring to have, responsibilities for leading teaching in a subject, year group, key stage or phase.



NPQ in Leading Teacher Development (NPQLTD)

For teachers who have, or are aspiring to have, responsibilities for leading the development of other teachers, curriculum leads, mentor or trainees in their school.



NPQ in Leading Behaviour & Culture (NPQLBC)

Designed for teachers who have, or are aspiring to have, responsibilities for leading behaviour and/or supporting pupil wellbeing in their school.



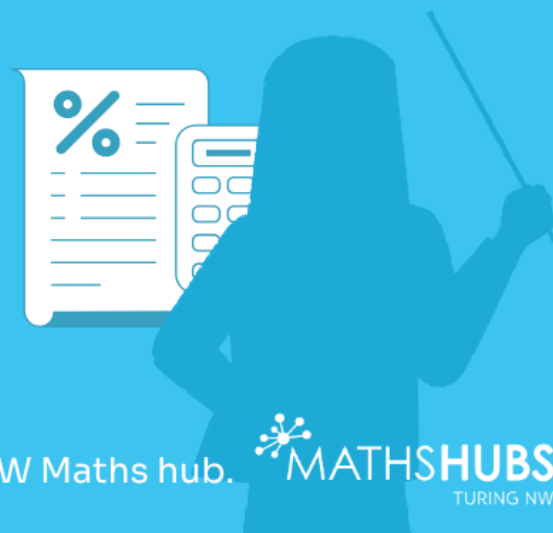
NPQ in Leading Literacy (NPQLL)

For teachers who have, or aspire to have, responsibility for leading literacy across a year group, key stage, phase or school.



NPQ in Leading Primary Maths (NPQLPM)

Specifically aimed at teachers and leaders with responsibility for leading maths across a primary key-stage or school, or those who are working towards having this responsibility.
